Youth College Scholarship Application

The Kansas Tractor Club was formed in order to create a group of people with a common interest in antique machinery, agriculture, and to preserve and educate future generations about our agricultural heritage. The Kansas Tractor Club is promoting those interests by sharing knowledge, stories, parts, and anything else we can about the machinery of days past.

In order for the Kansas Tractor Club to reach those younger generations, we have established an annual scholarship program. A scholarship committee can award up to \$1000 annually to one individual or multiple individuals. This scholarship is available to anyone who is a current KTC member, member's child or grandchild. The applicant must attend a vocational school, a two year college, or a four year college. Each applicant is selected based on answers to three questions: What are your education goals? What is your future plans following your education? And, why do you feel you deserve the scholarship?

If you or a family member, are enrolled or have been accepted at a (4) four year, (2) year and/or a Technical College is interested in applying for the scholarship, you may complete the scholarship form at the bottom of this form, or we can send a form by mail. (Contact information is below).

This Adobe form has fillable form fields so you can complete the form online and then submit it by email. You must send a copy of the Letter of Acceptance to a school you plan to attend. Do ONE of these options:

- Scan the original document and email,
- Take a picture of the original document and email
- Ask the Admissions department to email a copy of the document
- Or just send a copy of the document (letter of acceptance) in postal mail and we will match it with your submitted application.

Be sure to ask for a Received Receipt when you email so you have confirmation that your application arrived. And print a copy of your completed application for your records!

The scholarship must be submitted to the Committee on or before July 15th. Scholarship winner will be notified on or before September 15th of the same year.

Winners will be invited to the KTC Annual February meeting to meet the members and give update on the education.

Winners will receive a year membership to the KTC.
