The scholarship committee can award up to \$1000 annually to one individual or two \$500 for two individuals. This scholarship is available to anyone who are registered to attend a vocational school, a two- year college, or a four year college. Each applicant is selected based on answers to three questions: What are your education goals? What is your future plans following your education? And, why do you feel you deserve the scholarship?

If you are enrolled and have been accepted at a (4) four year, (2) year and/or a Technical College are interested in applying for the scholarship, you may complete the scholarship form at the bottom of this form. Or we can send you a form by mail. (Contact information is below).

This Adobe form has fillable form fields so you can complete the form online and then submit it by email. You must send a copy of the Letter of Acceptance to a school you plan to attend. Do ONE of these options:

- Scan the original document and email,
- Take a picture of the original document and email
- Ask the Admissions department to email a copy of the document
- Or just send a copy of the document (letter of acceptance) in postal mail and we will match it with your submitted application.

If you mail your application, ask for a Received Receipt so you have confirmation that your application arrived. And print a copy of your completed application for your records!

The scholarship must be submitted to the Committee on or before July 15th. Scholarship winner will be notified and awarded their scholarship endorsed to your chosen school on or before September 15th of the same year.

Winners will be invited to the KTC Annual February meeting to meet the members and give update on the education. In addition you will receive a year subscription to the Kansas Tractor Club.

Winners will receive a year membership to the KTC.
